What's for Dinner?

Plan a meal where you vote on what to eat. You could have the parent primarily responsible for cooking offer 2-3 choices and have one round of voting (simple majority rules ballot) or you could have each family member select a favorite meal choice (primary) and try to convince other family members to vote for it (debate) with a final vote afterwards. How different did this meal end up being from the Week One dinner?

Family Activities

- Hold a family meeting and allow each family member to express their input on an issue having to do with your family (like bedtime, chores, etc.) Practice listening to learn, not listening to respond/argue.
- 2. Talk about an issue in your local community or school. Try to examine the problem from different perspectives.

- 4. (service to others) Sometimes people need our help to make their voices heard. Pick an issue that is important to your family and use social media OR create posters to amplify the voices of those working on that issue.
