Musical Notes From Lisa Utzig, Music Director

WoO is not a typo (though I am excited to be presenting these Ecossaises today. Woo!). It stands for "Werke ohne Opuszahl" which is German for "works without an opus number." It's a term that's mostly used to refer to Beethoven works, because he left so many partially-finished or un-numbered pieces that music historians had to start numbering them to keep them all straight. In fact, there are over 200 WoO in the official Beethoven catalogue, including one of his most iconic piano pieces: Bagatelle in A minor (WoO 59), better known as Für Elise.

Towards the end of his life when he was entirely deaf, Beethoven communicated with people mostly by having them write down their side of the conversation to him in notebooks. These notebooks give us a lot of information on the little details of his day-to-day life-- for instance, we know that he got a haircut right before the premiere of his 9th Symphony, because several people he talked to in the book complimented him on it.
